Directions to Bright Side Manor

From Route 4

Route 4 to Teaneck Road exit (toward Ridgefield Park)

Follow Teaneck Road through the light at DeGraw Avenue.

Bright Side Manor will be on the right – yellow building. If you pass Dairy Queen, you've gone too far.

From Route 46

Route 46 to Teaneck Road exit (north)

Follow Teaneck Road past Dairy Queen on your left

Bright Side Manor will be on your left just past Dairy Queen
