Forum for Non-Profit Executive Directors to be Held

North Jersey--The Volunteer Center of Bergen County will host an Executive Directors' Roundtable on Thursday, November 12, 2009, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am at the Center's offices at 64 Passaic Street in Hackensack.

Executive Directors, CEOs and trustees from non-profit and government agencies are invited to attend this forum to develop strategies that maintain organizational integrity in the face of prolonged challenges to fiscal stability. Ken Berger, CEO of Charity Navigator, will add his perspective as a leader of a national nonprofit organization which has its operational offices in Bergen County.

Discussion topics will include: educating Boards of Directors about realistic fundraising expectations in the present economic climate; developing budget contingencies for the long haul; using the combined, proactive power of nonprofits to leverage joint purchasing; combining resources for "back office" operations and other topics of participants' choice.
